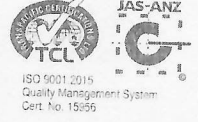

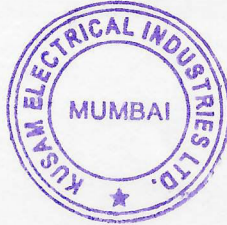

India are all set to face Germany in the Paris Olympics 2024 hockey semifinal, which will be a rematch of the bronze medal tie from Tokyo 2020. Both teams are giants of the game and will be aiming to serve another thriller for the hockey fans.

India vs Germany: Head to Head

India and Germany have played 18 matches so far, with India leading the head to head 8-6. 4 matches have finished in draws. India has scored 41 goals while Germany has hit 37 in these matches. The most famous encounter in recent times between these two giants was the Bronze medal match in Tokyo Olympics. India secured a thrilling 5-4 win, thanks to last-gasp stop by Sreejesh from a PC in the final moments of the match. In the last 6 meetings between these sides, India has won 5 of them. The last game between the two was in the FIH Pro League where Germany edged past with a 3-2 win.

Lakshya Sen's bronze medal match vs Zii Jia Lee in Paris: When and where to watch

New Delhi India's star shuttler Lakshya Sen will be in action on day 10 at the Paris Olympics 2024. The 22-year-old will fight it out for the bronze medal against Malaysia's Zii Jia Lee on August 5, Monday. He will be vying to bring India their 4th medal at the Paris Games when he will take part in the men's singles third-place match. History beckons Lakshya as he has chance to become the first Indian to win an Olympic medal in the men's badminton category. If he wins, he will become only the third Indian to win an Olympic medal in badminton after Saina Nehwal and PV Sindhu. The world No. 22 enjoyed a sensational run in the lead-up to the semifinals in the men's singles event. The unseeded player ended his group stage at top as he also defeated world No. 4 Jonatan Christie of Indonesia. He overcame his Indian counterpart HS Prannoy in round of 16 and overcame China's Chou Tien-chen in the quarter-final. However, he lost the semi-final battle against Victor Axelsen in straight sets.

However, Lakshya Sen holds an edge against his Malaysian opponent in the head-to-head battle. He has faced Lee Zii Jia five times so



far and won four of those matches. New Delhi. India are all set for their semifinal clash in hockey, and they will be facing none other than the world champions Germany in the clash. The Indian team had made secured a miraculous win on August 4, Sunday as they literally defied the odds to go past Great Britain. In a match that was marred by controversy, India were reduced to 10 men as Amit Rohidas was given a red card by the referee. Forced to play more than 45

minutes with just 10 men, it seemed like the task was going to be impossible for the Indian side as Great Britain launched attack after attack. However, PR Sreejesh and the Indian defence stood their ground and thwarted every single attack as Great Britain were unable to take the lead as the game ended 1-1. Then came the dreaded penalty shootout, where Sreejesh once again proved why he is the best in the business. India won 4-2 as Sreejesh pulled

off a fine save as the Indian players all converted their chances. Now, they will be facing Germany, who went past Argentina in the other quarterfinal. Gonzalo Peillat, an Olympic gold medal winner with Argentina, came back to haunt his former side on Sunday as he was one of the goalscorers for Germany in a thrilling match that would end 3-2. The other quarterfinals saw both Belgium and Australia, finalists from Tokyo, get

How call to therapist helped Noah Lyles claim Olympics gold in Paris

New Delhi After years of rebuilding his mental health, Noah Lyles reached the pinnacle of his sport, clinching the Olympic gold in the 100 meters on Sunday. A crucial phone call with his therapist after a tense semi-final round was instrumental in his victory. Lyles delivered a stellar performance, winning the 100 meters gold by a mere five-thousandths of a second with a time of 9.79 seconds. The final was intensely competitive, with Jamaican sprinter Oblique Seville finishing last despite clocking 9.91 seconds. In the semi-final, Seville had outpaced Lyles, necessitating a shift in mindset for Lyles ahead of the final. Speaking after the win, as quoted by Reuters, Lyles detailed how he had a call with his therapist who told him to let go, relax and be himself in the final race. "I wouldn't say nervous - I'd say I was extremely curious as to what was going to happen. That's how me and my therapist phrase it. I'm curious as to what I'm going to do, how am I going to pull this off," he told



reporters. "I came in third-fastest from the semis. I'm like 'This is going to be serious, this is not going to be easy'. And I had said OK, my therapist said 'You need to let go, you need to relax and you need to be yourself.'" **Did this against the best of the best** The U.S. sprinter, who has openly shared his mental health journey, knew the importance of being mentally prepared. Lyles' familiarity with the highs and lows of his sport stems from a personal journey of

overcoming depression, a struggle he faced three years ago. The three-time 200m world champion's journey hit a low point in 2021 when he failed to qualify for the 100 meters at the U.S. Olympic trials. Determined to become the fastest man on earth, he focused on rebuilding both his body and mind. This victory in Paris marks the culmination of Lyles' relentless effort and dedication to his mental and physical well-being, underscoring the importance of mental health in achieving athletic excellence. "I did this against the best of the best, on the biggest stage, with the biggest pressure," Lyles said. "And I wasn't even entered in the 100 in 2021. You know, here I am, first Olympics in the 100, going around now the Olympic champion." Lyles will now be in action in the 200 m event as he bids to complete a rare sprint double at the Olympics. The opening rounds of the event is set to be held on Monday, August 5.

Rohit Sharma first Indian, second overall batter to hit 300 sixes in ODI cricket

Rohit Sharma has achieved a significant milestone by becoming the first Indian and second overall batter to hit 300 sixes in One-Day Internationals. Despite India's 32-run defeat against Sri Lanka, Rohit's accomplishment was a standout moment.



New Delhi, Indian captain Rohit Sharma etched his name into the record books again, becoming the first Indian and second overall batter to hit 300 sixes in One-Day Internationals (ODIs). Rohit achieved this remarkable feat during India's 32-run defeat against Sri Lanka in the second ODI in Colombo on Sunday. Rohit's blistering knock of 64 runs from just 44 balls included four towering sixes and five elegant fours. Despite the team's loss, his milestone was a standout achievement in the match. This innings brought his career tally of sixes as an

opener to an impressive 302 from 177 matches, making him the second opener in history to cross the 300-sixes mark in ODIs. He trails only the legendary Chris Gayle, who has smashed 328 sixes in 280 games. Sanath Jayasuriya, the current Sri Lankan coach and a former explosive opener, ranks third on the list with 263 sixes from 388 ODIs. Rohit Sharma's career as an opener has been nothing short of phenomenal. With 8,801 runs from 177 matches, he has amassed 29 centuries and 55 fifties, maintaining a stellar average of 55. These statistics highlight his consistency and dominance at the top of the order. In the overall list of most sixes in ODIs, Rohit stands third with 330 sixes in 264 matches. He is surpassed only by Pakistan's Shahid Afridi, who tops the list with 351 sixes from 398 games, and Chris Gayle, who is just one six ahead with 331 sixes from 301 matches. Rohit also holds the record for the most sixes by an Indian in ODIs, surpassing notable names like Mahendra Singh Dhoni (229 sixes from 297 matches) and Sachin Tendulkar (195 sixes from 463 games). Moreover, across all three formats in international cricket—Tests, ODIs, and T20Is—Rohit Sharma leads the charts for the most sixes with a staggering 619 sixes from 482 matches.

Novak Djokovic aims to play LA 2028 Games after gold medal win in Paris Olympics

Novak Djokovic is already aiming to play in the Los Angeles Olympics 2028 after his gold medal win at the Paris Olympics 2024.

ever had and the most special feeling," the 37-year-old Serb said. "I want to play in Los Angeles. I enjoy playing for my country in the Olympic Games, in the Davis Cup," he added. Djokovic won a bronze medal in the Beijing Olympics 2008 and lost three semifinals before clinching the gold medal at the Paris Games.



Djokovic wins gold in Paris With the historic win, Djokovic joined Andre Agassi, Rafael Nadal, Steffi Graf and Serena Williams in an elite club. These are the only players to win all four Grand Slam tournaments and Olympic singles gold, completing the career Golden Slam. "I thought carrying the flag at the opening ceremony for my country at the 2012 Olympics was the best feeling an athlete could have until today," Djokovic, who has won a men's record 24 majors and swept up every title there is in tennis, finally clinched

Olympic gold at his fifth Games. He also managed to beat Alcaraz, who got the better of him in two consecutive Wimbledon finals. The 37-year-old said that he was not assured of a win until the final shot and gave his everything thinking that this could be his last shot at the Olympic gold. "Now at the age of 37 and facing a 21-year-old who is probably the best player in the world right now, winning Roland Garros and Wimbledon

back-to-back, I can say that this is probably the biggest sporting success I have ever had." How Wimbledon loss worked in Djokovic's favour? "We almost played three hours, the final shot was the only moment when I was sure I could win the match," said Djokovic. "I knew that this could be my last chance of a gold medal," added Djokovic at his post-final press conference still draped in his country's flag and with his medal hanging proudly around his neck. "I did everything I possibly could to prepare myself for this period. The injury sidetracked me a little bit. But coming into the Olympic Games, I felt like a different player in terms of how I moved, how I played. Alcaraz, 21, was also in tears after the match, but became the youngest to win a silver medal in the tennis event on his Olympic debut." In a way losing heavily to Alcaraz at Wimbledon probably worked in his favour as I knew I couldn't play any worse than that."
